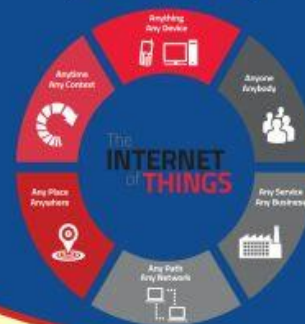

All submissions should be made in MS Word format.

The manuscript should not exceed 4,500 words (About 15 A-4 pages typed in double space).

The cover page should bear only the title of the paper, name/s of author/s, their official address. E-mail ID, phone/fax no., and acknowledgement (if any).

The first page of manuscript (after the cover page) should contain the title and the abstract only.

Footnote should be kept to a minimum and be numbered consecutively throughout the text with superscript Arabic numerals.

Lastly papers which focus on the conference theme would be given top priority in the selection process.

Guidelines for Abstract

The Abstract should not exceed 500 words and should include:

- * Title
- * Background
- * Objectives
- * Methodology
- * Work done
- * Findings/Results
- * List of references

The Contributor(s) should kindly provide their name/s, affiliation, mailing address, e-mail and phone number along with the abstract.

Review Process

The manuscript will be subjected to a critical review. The decision of the reviewers will be final and binding in all respect.
