#### -Students' Grievance Redressal Committee




#### MAJOR ACTIVITIES ORGANISED DURING THE SESSION

### 13th-15th October 2022






### **Scouts & Guides Camp**






#### **Mock Interview**




# **Poster Making Competition**

#### 24<sup>th</sup> December 2022






# **National Youth Day**




# **Debate Competition**

Career Academy, a unit of Prime Vision Educom Pvt. Ltd. This placement drive marked another step towards empowering our students with promising career opportunities.




### Aaj Tak Visit




# IT Quiz







# **Online Guest Lecture**






# **Martyrs Day**




### **Inter departmental Quiz**

### **Guest lecture**


# 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2023


#### 10. BEST PRACTICES FOR THE SESSION 2022-23

### 2. Competition:


• The presence of numerous educational institutions in the region creates a highly competitive environment, necessitating continuous improvement and innovation to attract and retain students.
